- Allowing extra time since this is the first one where they will have to organize into sixes

Camping - 35 min

Camp Overview 5 minutes

- Review camp activities and schedule with the group and field a couple of questions (**NESTOR**)
- Roughly:
 - Friday night
 - arrive / unpack
 - mug up
 - Saturday
 - Breakfast
 - Stations and games
 - Lunch (hot dog roast like last year?)
 - Stations and games
 - Dinner
 - Free time
 - Camp fire
 - Sunday
 - Breakfast
 - Scouts Own
 - Camp tear down
- Talk about what we did last year, ask kids what they liked

Packing/Equipment Inspection – 20 minutes (or more if needed)

- Break out into sixes, one leader for each six
- Cubs should have brought what they are taking to camp, leaders are to inspect gear and point out what's missing based on Gosia's list

- Leaders should make sure their cub has brought gear so we can at least show something if no one else has brought any in
- Discuss keeping warm at night:
 - Talk about temperature ratings on sleeping bags, show where it can be found on one of the bags
 - Generally want to pack a bag that is good for 10 degrees below expected overnight temperature
 - Bring a toque to keep your head warm
 - Keep dry sweatpants and sweatshirt accessible to put on during night if cold

Sleeping Bag Rolling/Unrolling - 10 minutes (eliminate if need more time for equipment inspection)

- In sixes
- Find temperature ratings on sleeping bags that they have brought with them
- Practice unrolling and rolling bags
- If that goes quickly, have them race as a group

Materials / References

- Packed camp bags, sleeping bags, sleeping pad
 - Each Cub asked to bring what they will take to camp with them (underpants should be left home since we will be reviewing in groups!)
 - Each leader should make sure that they bring their Cub's equipment + sleeping bag, pad so that we have something to review with each group if they don't bring their own
 - Extra sleeping bags would be useful to show
